Director - Amy Fowler



Director **Amy Fowler** is the Head FH Coach at **Dartmouth College**. 2010 marks the 4th summer for Peak FH Camps. Coach Fowler is excited about the 4th season of Peak FH. Coach Fowler has been at the helm for Dartmouth since the fall of 2000. In 2001, Fowler led her squad to the best record in the program's history at 15-4. That same year, Coach Fowler led her team to the ECAC Championship Title- the 2nd in the program's history. The Big Green finished 9-8 record in 2009 and 3rd in the Ivies. A three-time All-American defender for the University of Iowa, Fowler remains active at the developmental level for USA Field Hockey and is Level 2 certified. She welcomes you to camp in 2010.

Assistant Director - Andy Smith

Asst. Director **Andy Smith** is the Associate Head FH Coach at Dartmouth. Andy has been a part of the Dartmouth staff for eight years. Andy is one of a handful of FIH certified coaches in the US. He hails from Doncaster, England where he played and coached for 15 years. Andy will oversee the on-field playing activities during camp and is in his 4th year with Peak FH.



Assistant Director - Emily Rinde-Thorsen

Asst. Director **Emily Rinde-Thorsen** is an Assistant FH Coach at KUA and also runs her own private goalkeeping consulting company, Step-Up Consulting. Emily has worked various US developmental camps since graduating from the University of Iowa in 2003, where she was named Academic All Big Ten and to the National Academic Squad from 2000-03. She is in her 4th year with Peak FH.



Camp Mission

Welcome to our 4th year of the Peak Field Hockey Camps, to be held at Kimball Union Academy (Session 1) and Dartmouth College (Sessions 2 and 3). Our mission at Peak is to generate a passion for the game of field hockey, while showing young athletes how to improve and succeed on the field (both female and male players are welcome to attend camp). Each session provides our campers with basic fundamentals as well as more advanced skills. Campers are encouraged to take these concepts back to their own field hockey programs in the fall, where they can continue to work to improve their personal, as well as their tactical understanding of the game. All three sessions offer overnight and day camper options.

First Class Facilities

Peak Field Hockey Camps will provide a perfect balance of skill development and camaraderie for motivated field hockey players. Campers will receive a rigorous program of field hockey training, in a historic New England setting. They are housed in campus dormitories and experience traditional boarding school/college living. Campers at ALL sessions will train on synthetic turf fields (and natural grass at Session 1). **NOTE: Peak will attempt to grant all roommate requests, which have been made PRIOR to June 1st. Beyond this date, requests CANNOT be guaranteed. Be aware that assigned dorm layout may offer singles, in which case, requests will be placed in adjacent rooms.**

Camp Description

Session 1 (ages 5-13yrs- Youth and ages 14-18yrs- HS level) focuses on fundamental skill development as well as tactical elements of the game. All campers will be challenged with sport specific drills and team play that reflect the latest innovation and techniques used in the sport. Day and overnight sessions will be offered. *Campers will play on turf surface and possibly grass. Please bring both types of footwear.*

Session 2 and 3 are **HS aged** camps geared towards the serious player, interested in furthering her/his playing career to the next level. Camp curriculum includes an emphasis on fundamental skills, while introducing more advanced skills training and a tactical look at the game. *S2 is geared towards individual campers; S3 is recommended for teams who wish to attend camp together. *Campers will play on turf surfaces only.*

***Special goalkeeping instruction available at all three camp sessions.**
